

OUTDOOR SERVICES GUIDELINES

- 1.** Outdoor services on the lawn will begin at 9:30AM each Sunday. Hopefully, we'll have dry Sunday mornings and cooler temps. There will be designated seating areas on the lawn clearly marked as well as a few canopies in the back for those who are extremely sensitive to the sun. Wherever you sit, please maintain good social distancing practices. Parking lot attendants will be available to help you navigate through our designated traffic-flow patterns.
- 2.** Adult Sunday School classes will meet at 11AM—either in a socially distanced circle on the lawn or virtually on Zoom, as we've been doing.
- 3.** Bring with you items like camp chairs or blankets to sit on, your own coffee/water/snacks, items for your children/grandchildren to interact with while they sit together with you, masks to wear (we'll have some available for anyone who doesn't have one), your Bible, and a heart ready for worship. You may also want to sunscreen/bug spray up before you arrive just in case. We'll also have hand sanitizer stations throughout the venue.

- 4.** Dress comfortably—shorts, t-shirts, polo shirts, flip-flops, sandals, etc. will be very appropriate for this outdoor setting.
- 5.** We'll have a downloadable order of worship bulletin with song lyrics that you can easily carry with you on your smartphone or can print off at home to bring with you. We'll have a few hard copies available on-site, but we want to minimize any physical contact as much as possible.
- 6.** Speaking of which, we'll have clearly marked tables with baskets on them for those that prefer to bring their offering in person. We won't be "passing the plate," but you can drop your gift in the basket at any time you'd like to (similar to the way in which we bring our Faith Promise pledge cards).
- 7.** Our indoor bathrooms will be open and available for anyone who needs to use the restroom. Otherwise, the building will be closed off and we are asking folks not to wander into other portions of the building. Parents, we're asking you to accompany your children to/from the restroom.
