

BIBLE VERSE PRACTICE GAME



A family game to play to practice memorizing Ephesians 6:11

1. **SAY: *One piece of God's armor is the sword of the Spirit. The sword of the Spirit is actually the Bible! When we remember what the Bible says, we can use it as a weapon against the enemy's lies and tricks. The devil may try to trick us into thinking that God's armor is not that powerful, but we can memorize this verse to help us know the truth. Say it after me*** (motions optional for 4-5 grades):

 "Put on (cross arms on chest)
 All of God's armor. (move hands from head to toes)
 Then you can remain strong (make muscles with arms)
 Against the devil's evil plans." (put fists on hips)
 Ephesians 6:11 (make book with hands)
2. PRACTICE saying the verse two times, having them repeat each line.
3. **SAY: *Let's play a game to keep practicing the verse!***
4. HAVE kids put their feet in the center of the group. Going around the circle, HAVE each child stomp their foot and say a word of the memory verse. The child who says, "Ephesians 6:11" should pull one foot away from the center. CONTINUE playing until only one child's foot is left in the center. That child is the winner!
