PIKA

- You can find them in the forests of Colorado.
- They always stick together to protect each other.
- They collect food all year so they don't have to work during the winter.



RIVER OTTER

- They can hold their breath for up to eight minutes while under water.
- Baby otters are called pups.
- Otters always wash themselves after every meal.



KIT FOX

- These are the smallest foxes on the planet!
 They only weigh about four pounds. That's smaller than most human babies.
- They eat pretty much anything, and they hunt at different times of day.
- They can be many different colors, but the tip of their tail is always black.



KANGAROO RAT

- They are nocturnal animals, which means they sleep during the day and are awake during the night.
- They mostly eat seeds and beans. But if they're really hungry, they might even eat an insect.
- Like a kangaroo, they have a front pouch that they use to protect and carry their food.



PYGMY RABBIT

- They burrow near tall grass to keep safe from enemies.
- The pygmy is the smallest rabbit on the planet! They only weigh about one pound. That's only as much as a big bag of skittles!
- They are the only rabbits in the United States that make their own burrows. All other rabbits find holes in the ground made by other animals.



RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD

- They can see almost every color in existence, even colors human eyes can't see!
- The eggs of this bird are about the size of a green pea.
- They can fly for 20 hours straight without having to stop for food or rest. That's almost an entire day!
