WEEK 2 Pre-K-3rd BIBLE LESSON



Need to Know: Nothing Is Impossible for God **Bible Story:** An Angel Visits Mary (Luke 1:26-55) **Supplies:** Attached Bible Story Comic Strip, Bible Story Sheet, crayons/markers

- 1. SAY: There once was woman named Mary. Let's make a comic strip as we learn her story.
- 2. GIVE each child a **Bible Story Comic Strip**, and PLACE crayons/markers in the center of the group.
- 3. READ the **Bible Story Sheet** to the group, and HELP kids with the drawing prompts as needed.
- 4. After you're finished reading, ASK:
 - What did Gabriel tell Mary: she would have a son or she won a trip to the North Pole? (She would have a son) You got it!
 - Whose power did Gabriel say would help Mary? (God's) Is anything impossible for God? (No, nothing is impossible for God)
- 5. SAY: It seems like it would be impossible for Mary to have God's Son. Things that are impossible for people to do aren't impossible for God. Nothing is impossible for God!
