# WEEK 5 BIBLE LESSON

**Need to Know:** We Should Tell Others About Jesus

**Bible Story:** The Shepherds (Luke 2:8-20)

**Supplies:** Attached Picture Cards (printed & cut) and Bible Story Sheet



- 1. SAY: Some people in the Bible understood that it was important to tell other people about Jesus. Let's read to find out how they did it by playing a game!
- 2. Pass all of the **Picture Cards** out to the group. Then, SAY: **As I'm reading, listen for me to say what's on your Card.** When you hear me say it, hold it up really fast and show it to the group.
- 3. READ the Bible Story Sheet out loud (help younger kids to know when to raise their card). Then, ASK:
  - What did the angel tell the shepherds? (Our Savior had been born in Bethlehem)
  - Why do you think the shepherds wanted to tell others about this baby? (Because baby Jesus was the Savior that could fix everyone's friendship with God)
- 4. SAY: The news that God has sent His Son to be the Savior of the world is such good news that we can't keep it to ourselves. Others need to know this good news so that they can let Jesus be their Savior and have their friendship fixed with God, too. So what do we need to know today? (We Should Tell Others About Jesus)

#### **BIBLE STORY SHEET**

As you READ the following story, kids should hold up a **Picture Card** for each underlined word. Some **Cards** will be held up more than once.

On the night that God's Son, Jesus, was born, there were <u>shepherds</u> watching their <u>sheep</u> in a <u>field</u> near Bethlehem. All of a sudden, an <u>angel</u> came down to them from the Lord. The brightness of the Lord's glory was shining all around them! The <u>shepherds</u> fell down to their knees, and they put their <u>hands</u> over their <u>eyes</u>. They were very <u>afraid</u>!

The <u>angel</u> said, "Don't be <u>afraid</u>! I have good news for you, which will make everyone <u>happy</u>." The <u>angel</u> went on to say that a Savior named Jesus had been born in Bethlehem. This is the Savior that the people had been waiting for--the one who could fix their friendship with God! The <u>angel</u> told the <u>shepherds</u> that they could find Jesus lying in a <u>manger</u>. Suddenly, many other <u>angels</u> came down from heaven and started singing praises to God!


The <u>shepherds</u> decided that they needed to go find this Savior, Jesus! He was very special because they knew He was the only one who could fix their friendship with God! The <u>shepherds</u> wanted to tell everyone that Jesus was born and that He was the Savior of the world!
