WEEK 1 | K-3 | PARENT LESSON GUIDE

Need to Know: I Can Talk to God Bible Story: The Lord's Prayer Bible Reference: Matthew 6:5-15, Luke 11:1-13



READ THE BIBLE

DO

Read the **Bible Story Sheet** aloud to the group, using a **dry erase marker** to draw on a **dry erase board** as prompted. Erase with a **paper towel** as needed. You can also use blank paper to draw on.

SAY

- Did Jesus say it's better to pray as loud as you can or by yourself? (By yourself) Yes! He said this because the Pharisees were praying to show off instead of just wanting to talk to God.
- Is praying supposed to be easy or hard? (Easy) Praying is easy because it's just talking to God like He is your friend!

LET'S PRAY

DO

- 1. Give kids coloring utensils and a Prayer Map Coloring Sheet.
- 2. Starting at number 1 on the Prayer Map Coloring Sheet, have kids repeat after you as you tell them what each number says. Give them time to fill in the boxes with words or pictures before moving on to the next number.

LET'S PRACTICE

1. Take out a dry erase board, dry erase marker, and paper towel (or blank paper)

- 2. Draw a picture as shown in the left column on the **Leader Guide**, and let the kids guess what you are drawing.
- 3. Once they guess, read the corresponding text next to the picture on the Leader Guide.
- 4. Continue until all ten pictures have been drawn and discussed.

SAY God wants you and me to know we don't have to feel scared or worry about praying because it is just talking to our Father in heaven who loves us so much! Let me hear you say this after me one more time:

I Can (thumbs to chest) Talk to God (make praying hands)

MEMORIZE IT

SAY Today we're going to start memorizing a new Bible verse! Say this after me:

"Don't worry about anything. (make "X" with arms, shake head in "no" motion) No matter what happens, (arms out in "why" motion) tell God about everything. (arms up and out) Ask and pray, (make praying hands) and give thanks to Him." (wave both hands up high) Philippians 4:6 (make book with hands)

DO Have kids say the verse fast like they're running a race and then slowly as if in slow motion. Give kids coloring utensils and and allow them to color the Bible Verse Coloring Sheet.

DO

BIBLE STORY SHEET

Read and follow the instructions below, drawing on a dry erase board or blank paper when prompted and allowing kids to guess the picture as you draw.

Say: I'm going to draw a picture and you get to guess what I'm drawing. Then I will tell you what that picture means in our Bible story!

Draw an <u>ear</u> :	Then say: Did you know that you can pray and talk to God, and He will hear you? (Allow responses)
	Well, it's true! And that's why I drew an ear. Because you can talk to God any time, anywhere and know that He's all ears! One time, Jesus told a story to help us know how we should and should not pray.
Ŭ	Let's see if you can guess the next picture!
Draw a <u>mean face</u> :	Then say: It's a mean face. That's because this story is about some people, called Pharisees, who were not very nice. Everything these people did was to show off for other people, and they even tried to show off for God. If they did something kind, it was only so others would see it. And if they prayed, it was super loud because they were trying to make themselves sound better than others. But Jesus had something to say about it.
	What do you think Jesus told the people? (Allow responses) Let's see if you can guess what I draw next and we'll find out.
Draw a <u>person</u> :	Then say: It's a person! That's because Jesus told the people not to be like the Pharisees, showing off for others. And you'll notice that I only drew one person. That's because Jesus told people that when we pray, we should go into our room, close the door, and pray to our heavenly Father. Jesus was explaining that God cares most about who we are when no one else is watching. He just wants us to talk to Him about what's in our hearts.
	Let's see if you can guess what this next drawing means.
Draw a <u>person talking</u> :	Then say: It's a picture of someone talking because Jesus showed us how we can talk to God. Jesus said to pray like this, "Our Father in heaven, we pray that Your name will always be kept holy. We pray that Your kingdom will come, and that what You want will be done here on Earth, the same as in heaven. Give us the food we need for each day. Forgive our sins, just as we have forgiven those who did wrong to us. Don't let us be tempted, but save us from the Evil One." Jesus showed us that talking to God is simple! We can say, "Hey God," and tell Him how great He is. We can even say we're sorry for any wrong things we've done and ask Him for anything we need.
	Now let's see if you can guess the next picture!
Draw a <u>heart</u> :	Then say: It's a heart! I drew this because I want us to remember that God loves us so much, and He loves to hear us pray! Do you think God ever gets tired of hearing you talk to Him? (No) No way! God loves to hear us talk to Him no matter if we are happy, sad, excited, or sick. It's always a good time to talk to God!

PRAYER MAP

We can pray like Jesus taught us to pray using simple words. Just fill in the blanks with your own words or pictures.






