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


1. What happened when Jesus entered Jerusalem?


2. Why did the people wave their palm branches?














PIN THE JESUS ON THE DONKEY

Supplies:

- Donkey printable*
- Jesus cutout printable*

- Blindfold
- Tape

Directions:


- 1. Hang the donkey on a wall that has space for kids (and parents) to play.
- 2. Give each player a Jesus cutout and a piece of tape for their Jesus cutout.
- 3. Blindfold one player at a time and spin them around 3 times, ending with the child facing toward the donkey.
- 4. Each player will try to "pin" the Jesus so he is perfectly sitting on top of the donkey.
- 5. The player closest to getting Jesus sitting on the donkey, wins.

TALKING POINTS

Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- That was a fun game to play to help us celebrate Easter! Jesus is our good King.
- What are some things you think about when you think of a king?
- What do you think about Jesus riding a donkey?
- In real life, Jesus had to ride a donkey into the city of Jerusalem because that is what was
 prophesied many years before Jesus was even born. This is one of the ways that Jesus
 showed he was the Messiah the one everyone had been waiting for who would save
 them.
- What are some good things Jesus has done that we can celebrate this Easter?
- Do you have any questions about the Bible story or anything from this week?
- What is one thing you are thankful for today? Let's talk to God and tell Him that and thank Him for sending Jesus on a donkey for us.
