CATEGORIES


Directions:

- 1. Get together with the people in your house and/or get on a video chat via FaceTime, Hangouts, Zoom, Marco Polo, etc. with friends and family outside your home.
- 2. One person will state a category like candy, movies, sports, etc.
- 3. Going around the circle, each player must name an item in that category. Everyone must remember what others have said so they do not repeat any item.
- 4. If they repeat it or can't think of one, they're out.
- 5. Continue playing with a new category and keep going.

TALKING POINTS

Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- That was a fun game to play to help use our memory! To do well you had to think and focus really hard to remember what other people said. Even when you did, it was sometimes hard to remember.
- That reminds us of the Bible story from this week at church. We saw that Jesus gave the
 disciples something to remember Him and it's important that we remember Jesus every
 day.
- What are some things you remember about Jesus?
- What are some things that make it difficult for you to remember Jesus?
- What are some ways we can remember Jesus every day as a family?
- Do you have any questions about the Bible story or anything from this week?
- What is one thing you are thankful for today? Let's talk to God and tell Him that and thank Him for sending Jesus.


- 1. What caused the men to realize it was Jesus they had been walking with?

- 3. One way we can remember what Jesus did is by reading about Him in our Bible. What's a story in the Bible you'd want to read together today?




Let's go on a scavenger hunt to find things that remind us of the Easter story! That way we can remember Jesus and what He did on Easter every day.

A rock - reminds us of Jesus' tomb
Two sticks - remind us of Jesus' cross
Something new - reminds us that Jesus gives us a new life NEW
Draw a cloud you see - reminds us that Jesus lives in Heaven
Something white - reminds us that Jesus forgave us
A fallen leaf - reminds us of the palm branches used during Jesus' triumphal entry
Draw an animal - reminds us of the donkey Jesus rode to Jerusalem
Something empty - reminds us of Jesus' empty tomb
Something black - reminds us that Jesus died for our sins
